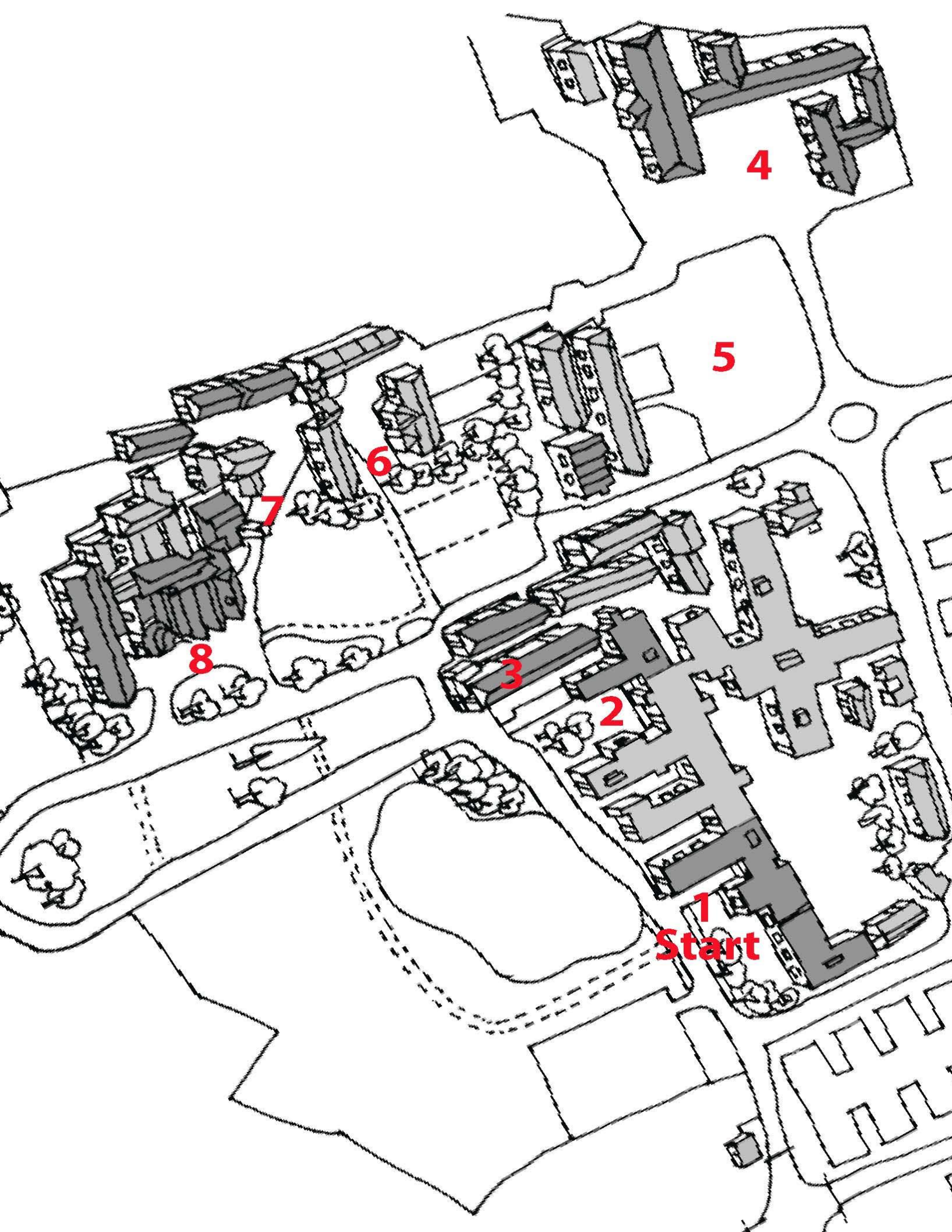


2. Go into the Churchill exhibition and see if you can name one of Churchill's hobbies?

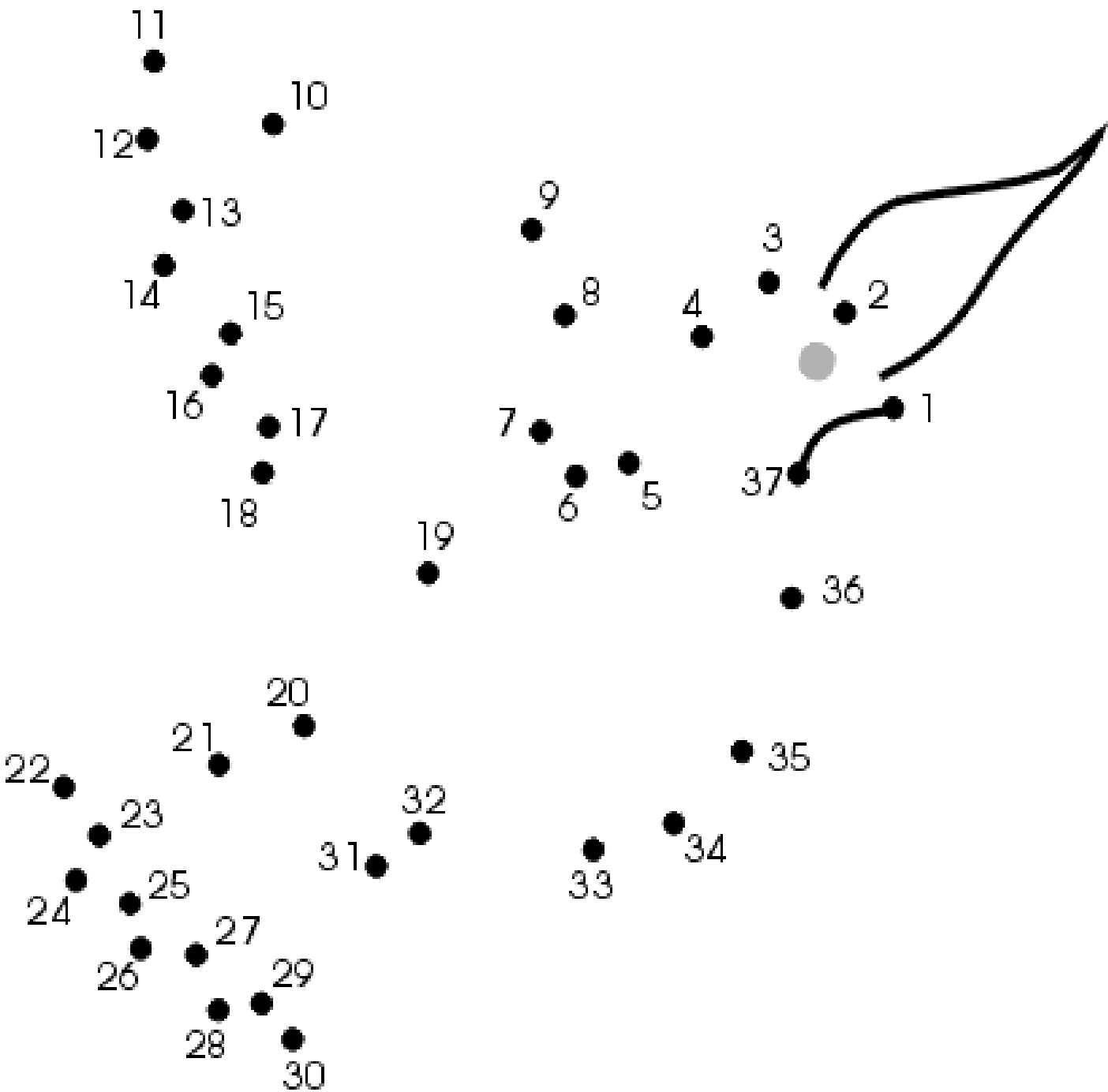
